

SWIMMER REQUIREMENTS

SWIM INSURANCE

Every swimmer must have their own comprehensive travel insurance. This is a condition of taking part – if satisfactory evidence is not provided, you will not be allowed to participate.

YOUR INSURANCE MUST COVER

- Albania, Greece and the waters between them.
- An organised, supported, long-distance open-water sea swim.
- The swim being a main purpose of your trip.
- Participation if the insurer classifies it as an endurance event, race, competition, charity event, cross-border swim or cross-channel swim.
- Illness and accidental injury.
- Emergency medical treatment.
- Ambulance and air ambulance.
- Maritime search and rescue.
- Emergency medical evacuation and repatriation.
- Repatriation of remains.

Declare everything. You must tell your insurer about all relevant medical conditions, medications and previous injuries.

WHAT TO ASK YOUR INSURER

SEND THIS WORDING TO YOUR INSURER OR BROKER

"Please confirm in writing that my policy covers me while participating in an organised, supported, long-distance open-water sea swim starting in Albania and finishing in Corfu, Greece, with safety boats. The swim is a main purpose of my trip and may be classified as an endurance event, race, competition, charity event, cross-border swim or cross-channel swim. Please also confirm that I am covered for emergency medical treatment, maritime rescue, medical evacuation and repatriation in Albania, Greece and all waters crossed."

WHAT YOU MUST UPLOAD

- 1** Your insurance certificate.
- 2** Your policy schedule showing your name, policy number, dates and geographical cover.
- 3** The policy wording or endorsement covering open-water swimming.
- 4** Written confirmation from your insurer or regulated broker that the Albania-to-Corfu swim is covered.

All four documents must be uploaded **before the deadline**.

NOT ACCEPTED

- ✗ A document that only says "travel insurance", "swimming" or "water sports".
- ✗ A GHIC or EHIC – these are not a substitute for this insurance.

PLEASE NOTE

Go Overboard will check that the required documents have been uploaded, but we cannot advise whether a policy is suitable or guarantee that an insurer will pay a claim. It is your responsibility to obtain appropriate insurance and comply with its conditions. **If satisfactory evidence is not provided, you will not be allowed to participate.**
